The Rules state that the candidate may be elected as a Member under the criteria below:-

No person shall be eligible for election as a Member of the Association unless they have satisfied rules 9 and 10 of the RSA rules (last update November 2012).

Rule 9:- Every candidate for election as a Member of the Association shall –

(1) Be a Fellow or Member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors or a Fellow, Member (Diploma Holder) or Member (Honours) of the Institute of Revenues, Rating and Valuation;

(2) Be practising or employed as a rating surveyor; and

(3) Have not less than five years' relevant valuation experience as a rating surveyor since obtaining a qualification referred to in (1)

Rule 10: The Committee may, notwithstanding 9, elect any person as a member of the Association if it is satisfied that –

(1) He or she has exceptional standing and experience as a rating surveyor; and

*(2) He or she is fully aware of the requirements of the Code of Conduct **

In addition the Member has read and understood rule 8 and 94.

Rule 8:- Members shall be entitled to describe themselves as "Member of the Rating Surveyors' Association" and may use the corresponding contraction "Member RSA". This excludes Affiliates who are to be called "Affiliate Members of the RSA" and Juniors who are to be called "Junior Members of the RSA".

Rule 94:- Members, Affiliates and Juniors shall comply with the Code of Conduct.*
